**What can you do for your parish?** We already have quite a few catechists, but we need more people to join the team. - serving the refreshments at the start of each session;

- looking after the children at Mass on Saturdays and Sundays (St. Patricks), as they help with the collection, meet and greet, say the bidding prayers, do the offertory procession etc;
- supporting parents during each learning session. (Parents sit with the children and study with them).
