Fasting & Abstinence in Lent – A guide: **Fasting:** for those between 16-60 years old. If you are outside this age group, you may wish to fast as a personal decision of faith. If you are ill or have long term conditions, you are not bound by fasting.

Abstinence: from meat or meat substitutes for those over the age of 14. Under this age abstinence is not required. Over 14 years there is no upper limit. Usually Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, or on days you want to choose also. **Days of Penance:** Ash Wednesday, Good Friday & Fridays of Lent. To make a specific act of sorrow for sins either through extra prayer, fasting or alms giving. **Giving something up for Lent:** this is a great tradition. We remember Jesus fasting for 40 days in the desert. In return, we give up something small like chocolate etc. Or we could give up our free time to do something for others as an act of charity. The gestures are not meant to be onerous.
