Saints this week:

Blessed Dominic: Born in Italy in 1792, he joined the Congregation of the Passion 1814 and ordained priest four years later. He came to work for the conversion of England. In the seven years of ministry in England he preached missions and retreats all over the country and received many distinguished people into full communion with the church including John Henry Newman.

St Augustine: Born in 354 in Italy. Thanks to the prayers of his mother, St Monica (Aug 27th) he was baptised and eventually was chosen as Bishop of Hippo in North Africa. He died in 430.

Ss. Margaret Clitherow, Anne Line and Margaret Ward: All three were Martyrs and are remembered for their resourcefulness, loyalty, outstanding courage and for the service they rendered the Church during dangerous times in aiding the ministry of priests.
