**PRAYER FOR THE SYNOD OF BISHOPS:** The second session of the Synod commenced on 2<sup>nd</sup> October. The Holy Father has requested the prayers of the whole Church during the Synod. During October, dedicated to Our Lady of the Rosary, please consider offering a decade of the Rosary each week to pray for the maternal intercession of the Mother of God, for the Church and for the members of the Synod.

**Christmas Fayre this year**: Will take place on Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> December at 11.30am after the morning Mass. The fayre provides a very important part of the income for the parish and the school. I have moved the fayre to a Sunday, in line with most other parishes, so that it attracts parishioners fresh from church. The doors will be open at 11.30 pm precisely so that everyone has a fair chance of bargain hunting. Stalls can be prepared on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> November in the afternoon.

**The Saint Vincent de Paul Society in our Parish** have spent the last year visiting the housebound and sick, taking Holy Communion to those who cannot get to Mass; supporting the Mini Vinnies in our primary school, giving lifts to people, buying food and clothing for the homeless and reaching out to those in need, wherever they are and whenever we become aware of their need. We need to grow however, to meet the demands of society and to reach those marginalised and struggling to survive. More members would enable us to join with others in an exciting venture to set up a "Repair Cafe", both to stop things going to landfill and to help those who cannot afford to repair their goods and to counteract the growth of consumerism. We need more full-time members as well as more auxiliary members who we can call upon for extra support and special events. (e.g. bakers, car drivers, fixers etc.). We would also like to encourage young people to have their own SVP so they too can learn to recognise need and do something about it - carrying on the tradition learnt in the Mini Vinnies. For this we need more members too. If you are at all interested, please get in touch with any SVP member especially over the coming few weeks when we will be having a push to raise awareness of the SVP.
