Proposal for a new Foundation Year at the School: St. Joseph's Catholic Primary, a Voluntary Academy, is a school for pupils aged 4 to 11. The school is a part form entry primary school and currently admits 20 pupils into the reception class each September. The School would like to lower the age of admission to 3 years by opening a new Foundation Stage Unit in September 2025. This would integrate the current Reception class and a pre-school provision into one unit. We propose to provide up to 10 morning and 10 afternoon high-quality places. The teacher led Foundation Stage Unit would run for 38 weeks per year in line with school term times; sessions would be from 8.50am -3.20pm Monday-Friday. Access to our before and after school will also be possible. We are seeking to open the Foundation Stage Unit and thereby lower the admission age. There is a great deal still to consider in relation to the proposal and we are very interested in finding out the views of our local community. We are seeking responses to this consultation by Friday 13th December 2024, either by sending the attached response form to the Headteacher, Mrs Wood in the post or by e-mail to bursar@stjosephs-barlick.lancs.sch.uk. Please note that the opening of this Foundation Stage Unit is dependent upon funding being secured for the capital costs.
