Joseph's Catholic Primary, a Voluntary Academy, is a school for pupils aged 4 to 11. The school is a part form entry primary school and currently admits 20 pupils into the reception class each September. The School would like to lower the age of admission to 3 years by opening a new Foundation Stage Unit in September 2025. This would integrate the current Reception class and a pre-school provision into one unit. We propose to provide up to 10 morning and 10 afternoon high-quality places. The teacher led Foundation Stage Unit would run for 38 weeks per year in line with school term times; sessions would be from 8.50am -3.20pm Monday-Friday. Access to our before and after school will also be possible. We are seeking to open the Foundation Stage Unit and thereby lower the admission age.
