Assist us to live, not die':

Parliament is about to have a third reading of the Bill that will give individuals the right to commit suicide with assistance by someone else. Please do collect the postcard, read and send it on to our MP. This Bill dangerously encourages coersion, improper safeguard guarantees, a slippery slope for expanding the remit, and a blatant disregard for the work of palliative care. We already have an existing Assisted Dying pathway in our country which needs more financial support from government to help the hospice movement and such like. The Bill has been called 'Assisted Dying' to avoid the word suicide for its obvious conertations. It is in effect a Bill to support assisted suicide. Please do act as a conscientious Catholic to stand up for the rights of the most vulnerable.
